Don Fontana is Gold Glove Baseball Camp's Director and a former assistant coach at The Catholic University of America, the University of Maryland, Georgetown University, and Niagara University. He has also worked as an instructor at the Old Dominion University Instructional Baseball Camps (VA), Home Run Baseball Camp (DC), the Princeton University/Babe Ruth Baseball Camps (NJ), along with the Best in Virginia Showcase Camps.

He began scouting with the Pittsburgh Pirates, as an Associate Scout from 2000-04, and is currently in his sixth year as a Scout with the Milwaukee Brewers. A three year letter-winner at catcher at Duquesne University (PA), he also taught 7th & 8th Grade U.S. History at the Catholic Academy of West Buffalo and holds a B.A. in Print Journalism from Duquesne and a M.S. in Secondary Education from Niagara University.

Equipment

Campers must wear baseball or sweat pants, a baseball hat, sneakers, and bring a baseball glove. Balls, bats, catcher's gear, batting helmets, and all other equipment will be provided by Gold Glove Baseball Camp. Campers may bring their personal bat or catching equipment. Program

Gold Glove Baseball Camp is designed for youngsters ages 6-12 who have a desire to learn and play the game of baseball. From the beginning player to the veteran Little Leaguer, the camp program promotes teamwork, learning, and fun by focusing on skill development through drills and game experience. In grouping players primarily by age, youngsters learn teamwork, patience, and encouragement. In the event of rain, campers will be taken indoors for individual skill development with the camp staff, a baseball video, trivia contest, along with other activities.

Complete Instructional Program



Hitting & Bunting: grip, stance, swing path, contact points, head position, follow through.

Throwing: footwork, grip, release points, arm path, eye position.

Fielding: footwork, fielding triangle, head position, forehand/backhand footwork, reading hops, catching fly-balls, taking proper fly ball routes.

Base-running: jumps out of the batter's box, ground-ball/fly-ball turns at first base, going from first base to third base, scoring from second base, leads from first base.

Pitching: wind-up and stretch mechanics
